

Study on Eating Disorders



You may be eligible to get paid to take an online survey about eating disorders. Your responses are completely confidential, so no one will ever see your answers. We want to hear from you about your experiences with eating disorders and other physical and mental health experiences. The baseline survey will take about 30-40 minutes and a follow-up survey at 6 and 12 months will take about 20 minutes to complete.

The survey is being conducted by RTI International, a non-profit research organization that has a long and distinguished history conducting surveys on health, including America's Best Hospitals from the U.S. News and World Report. Additional collaborators are from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, Stanford University, and the Binge Eating Disorder Association (BEDA).
